Recently, I had gone through a window of not feeling well, and went through a series of hospital scans. Having a history of cancer, of course concerns-- since they could not find out why the pain was initiating. Thanking God for His faithfulness and the power of prayer. After 4 weeks the pain finally subsided and the tests all came out clear! Glory to God! As God works all things together for good, along the way much favor, and He had given me many divine appointments during that time to share His love and Gospel in many ways wherever it seemed like this personal missionary journey took me. After managing the pain, life and ministry felt the Lord say... it's time to now REST, and I took some sabbatical days to come apart offered by a brother and sister in Christ who did not know me but heard I was sick. During that time of rest and meditation, a song kept going through my mind. It was the theme to the movie Rocky! Now you have to understand, I never saw the series of movies, so to hear this movie theme in my head was at first puzzling. Yet, I knew God could use anything so I leaned in to listen. After praying and feeling empowered, I got up, put on sweats and began to walk the Ocean Grove Boardwalk to listen and pray more. Each day reading His Word, and looking at YouTube clips to have a deeper understanding of the movies. The movie "Rocky" may not be a Christian theme, but there is a spirit-life application we can glean. You see after the death of Rocky's former Trainer, Mitch, a once rival fighting opponent Apollo-Creed steps up to become Rocky's new-trainer. These two men of different color begin to enter each other's lives together for later an unforgettable win.

In the midst of his grueling training by Creed for the big fight against Lang, Rocky begins to deal with guilt about the death of Mitch, and his own personal insecurities. But Rocky's wife Adrian, confronts the real deal, which is Rocky's fear of losing. Fear comes in many forms and can be rooted in rejection, abandonment, historic abusive experiences or failures or coming future events--which can bring about a paralyzing cycle-that only can be dissolved by awareness, admittance, forgiveness, repentance, where needed and of course the perfect LOVE of God! As Rocky, sometimes we need an Adrian in our lives, who will read our mail revealing the truth of the matter, and sometimes those that seem to be once opponents can regroup now having a true unified eternal personal win- pressing forward for the heavenly prize! (Philippians 3:14). But through it all, spiritual growth comes through going to the mats, resistance training, foot work and punching the bag beating against

the flesh, exercising our faith, as most of our growth does not come from Easy-Street or Broad Street, but it comes from the Narrow-Street as we walk with the Lord. I have never experienced the deeper growth without the struggle. We ALL have a sweet spot Satan will target, or a weakness he will go after -none of us is exempt. But I can tell you it will only make you stronger in Christ!

There may be times we can feel as though we took a sucker-punch ., as the reality of news hits your heart leaving you whirling! Each one of these "isms" have banged hard on the church doors, and we ALL have been in one way or another touched by them. We are living in a unprecedented window of time, when there's been an unleashing of evil that has worked on the sidelines watching and waiting, and comes now with the territorial spirit too try to take over as he understands clearly that ... "No kingdom divided against each other will stand." (Mark 3:24) You see I have been around long enough as decades passed to watch emotional experiences of what seems to be repentance of these "isms" fade into a memory and the cycle continues.
